Charging the Bluetooth Speaker

- 1. A rechargeable battery is built into the speaker.
- 2. Please charge for at least 2 hours before the first use.
- 3. Locate the Micro USB port and connect the Micro USB cable into the USB charging port. Connect the USB end into a USB wall socket/receiver or any powered USB port (computer, car, etc.).
- 4. The LED indicator will turn RED as the receiver is charging and turn OFF when fully charged.
- 5. A BLUE LED indicator lights up when the speaker is turned on.
- 6. Please note that a 5VDC charger or computer USB cable can be used for charging the Bluetooth speaker.

Pairing Instructions

- 1. Turn power switch ON.
- 2. On the audio device, navigate to the Bluetooth settings and enable Bluetooth. Scan for nearby
- 3. Locate the Bluetooth receiver on the list of devices labeled "FosPower BTS20" and connect to it.
- 4. The receiver will connect to the audio device when it is turned on.

NOTE: Compatible with Amazon Alexa and Google Home Bluetooth functionality.



Controls

Buttons/Controls

Power ON/OFF: Slide power switch

Play/Pause Track: Press the "play/pause" button once

Raise Volume: Press the "+" button once

Lower Volume: Press the "-" button once

Next Track: Press and hold the "+" button

Previous Track: Press and hold the "-" button

Answer or Hang Up a Call: Press the "play/pause" button Mode: Switches between radio and Bluetooth mode

Call Commands

Answer Incoming Call: Press the "play/pause" button

End Current Call: Press the "play/pause" button once durina a call

Redial Most Recent Contact: Quickly press the "play/pause" button twice

Play Audio with TF Card or U Disk

- 1. Power off Bluetooth speaker.
- 2. Insert TF Card or U Disk.
- 3. Turn power on and the Bluetooth speaker will automatically recognize the audio files and play them in the order stored on the card/disk.

Play External Audio Source

- 1. Connect the 3.5mm cable to the AUX port of the Bluetooth speaker and the output of your external
- 2. The Bluetooth speaker will automatically switch to AUX mode when inserting the 3.5mm cable into the

FM Radio

- 1. Connect the 3.5mm plug of the audio cable to AUX port to act as an antenna.
- 2. Press the "Mode" button to select radio mode.
- 3. Press "play/pause" button to start auto scanning. All available channels will be auto saved.
- 4. Press the Next/Previous Track buttons to select the desired radio station.

Precautions

If you experience discomfort, pain or ear fatigue, try lowering the volume or discontinuing use temporarily.

Do not use at high volumes. Listening with at high levels may damage your hearing.

Avoid extreme heat, cold and humidity.

Troubleshooting

[Speaker is not turning on]

Make sure the battery is charged sufficiently. Follow the charging instructions above if necessary.

[Low or no audio]

Make sure the speaker and the audio source are paired correctly through Bluetooth, Try adjusting volume settings and increase the volume if it is set too low

[Battery is not charging]

Check to see if the Micro USB cable is working properly. See if the charging cable is connected to a power source and receiving power.

[Speaker cannot be found through Bluetooth device]

Check and see if Bluetooth is working properly on the audio device. Make sure the device is within range, and that the receiver has enough battery power. Restart the audio device

[Signal drops or unwanted noise/interference]

This may be caused by wireless interference from nearby devices. Try moving the audio source closer to the speaker, or clear out any objects between the two devices. Turn off or move away from possible sources of interference, such as microwave ovens, cordless telephones, wireless speakers, routers, power sources, or any other wireless device.
